KIN ROSÉ

Delicious Grenache rosé, from old vine fruit, that dials up purity, energy and intensity in 2023. Delicate strawberry, white peach and rose petal aromas are followed by a shock of electric flavour on the palate and fine talcum powder tannin. Dry, crunchy and vibrant with juicy cranberry acidity through the finish.

[SEASON]

Even though 2023 will generally go down as a cool, wet and challenging year, we're delighted with the results. Freshness and purity are hallmarks of the vintage. Our healthy organic vineyard showed its resilience against mildew and other dangers and the late start to the season meant flavour and sugar ripeness dovetailed nicely. Most of our fruit came in over an intense 11 day period in late March before the weather turned cold and wet again.

[VINEYARD]

In 2023 all the fruit for this wine came from Block 7 in the Old Quarter, planted in the 1950s. NASAA certified organic and biodynamic.

[WINEMAKING]

Fruit was picked early and then lightly crushed and destemmed with the delicate, free run juice drained off to a stainless steel fermenter. We added some whole berries into the tank to build colour and let it ferment. After fermentation it spent time on lees before settling naturally prior to bottling in mid 2023.

[VARIETIES] 100% Grenache

[ALCOHOL] 13.5%

[PRODUCTION] 600 dozen made

[ABOUT ALKINA]

Alkina is a new story on an old place. Our certified organic and biodynamic farm sits on the traditional lands of the Ngadjuri people and we seek to honour the land's Indigenous history and to learn from their deep connection to country. We have 43 hectares of vines planted to Grenache, Shiraz, Mataro and Semillon, with the oldest vines dating from the 1950s.
